Dracula

Act I

Setting: London and Transylvania, 1897

Scene I: Jonathan Harker, working for a legal firm in London, is assigned to travel to Transylvaina to secure and finalize the purchase of Carfax, a London Estate for Count Dracula. He bids goodbye to Mina Murray, his fiancée.

Scene II:

During his travels to Transylvania, Jonathan is pursued by dogs, wolves, and bats.

Scene III: Dracula welcomes Harker to his home and offers him wine, but Jonathan can feel that something is not right. Dracula warns him to stay in his room and not to wander through the castle. As Jonathan settles into his room, he looks at his picture of his fiancée, Mina and becomes lonesome for her.

Scene IV: Harker is too curious about Dracula's castle and does not heed Dracula's warning. He finds an empty room that intrigues him and upon entering, he begins to feel chilled and fatigued. He decides to rest on an inviting couch, falls asleep, and suddenly notices that he is not alone...

Scene V: Mina and her dearest friend, Lucy Westerna, are having tea at Lucy's summer home in Whitby, when three of Lucy's suitors arrive. Dr. Jack Seward, then Quincy Morris ask for Lucy's hand in marriage. Lucy turns both of them down, holding out for her love, Lord Arthur Holmwood, who's marriage proposal, she happily accepts.

Scene VI: Mina and Lucy are walking together in the old cemetery overlooking the North Sea, admiring Lucy's engagement ring. Mina is happy for Lucy and Arthur, but is worried about Jonathan, from whom she has not heard anything in weeks. Dracula has come to England in pursuit of Mina, but knows he needs to get Lucy out of the way first. He lurks in the shadows, waiting until he has a moment alone with Lucy. Later that night, there is a strange storm and Mina discovers that Lucy has begun to wander the cemetery in her sleep.

Scene VII: Jonathan Harker manages to escape from Dracula's castle, but almost dies climbing down the castle wall. He is pursued by dogs, wolves, bats, and the vampire wives.

Scene VIII: Mina receives word that Jonathan is gravely ill. Although she is worried about Lucy, she goes to her beloved's side to marry him and nurse him back to health.

Scene IX: Lucy is dying. Dr. Jack Seward, calls on his teacher, Dr. Van Helsing, to evaluate and diagnose Lucy. Dr. Van Helsing sees Dracula's marks on her neck. One by one, all the men donate their blood to Lucy, but each night, Dracula returns to bite her and drink her blood. In the end, the men cannot save her.

Intermission

Act II

Scene I: In a London insane asylum, Dr. Jack Seward is treating his patient, R.M. Renfield. Renfield talks about the coming of "his master" and has an unusual appetite for spiders and rats. In addition, all of the other patients seem affected by Renfield's behavior. Meanwhile, Mina, Jonathan, Arthur, Quincy and Dr. Van Helsing have all joined Dr. Seward at the asylum to figure out how to hunt down Lucy's killer. Dracula eludes them all and finds his way to Mina.

Scene II: Young girls are playing in the area around the cemetery where Lucy has been put to rest. One by one, the girls go missing.

Scene III: Dr. Van Helsing realizes that Lucy is now "undead." He leads the men to her grave and they do what they must in order to put her soul to rest. Meanwhile, Dracula, upset with Renfield, re-enters the asylum and kills him. As he lies dying, Renfield warns the men that Dracula is after Mina.

Scene IV: Mina finds herself unable to resist Dracula's advances. She willingly drinks his blood to join Dracula in immortality.

Scene V: Dracula has escaped. Jonathan and the men follow Dracula back to Transylvania. They are met by the Gypsies, who urge the men not to go, telling them that no one enters Dracula's castle and comes out alive.

Scene VI: With Mina's life at stake, the men know they cannot fail in their pursuit of Dracula.

Chris Chlumsky (Upright Piano, Electric Bass) Chris is a highly in demand performer and teacher, primarily playing with national touring musicals at the Hippodrome Theater, National Theater and the Filene Center/Barns at Wolf trap in Virginia and as the alternate bassist for Kennedy Center musicals, Washington National Opera and alternate electric bassist with the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra. Chris also regularly performs with the Mid-Atlantic Symphony Orchestra as Principal, the American Pops Orchestra, The National Philharmonic, The Maryland Lyric Opera Orchestra, The National Chamber Ensemble, pit orchestra of the Tony Award winning Signature Theater, the Everyman Theater, the Olney Theater, Studio Theater of Washington, DC, Roundhouse, is the Assistant Principal of Alexandria Symphony Orchestra Theater, and substitutes with the Baltimore Chamber Orchestra. However, Chris's diverse range of musical styles doesn't stop with just classical and theater genres, and Chris actively plays jazz, funk, big band, and blues with many of the top regional bands as far south as Atlanta, GA to NYC.

Ray Tilkens (Guitar). Ray is a multi-instrumentalist, songwriter and recording engineer/producer. He has worked and collaborated with notables such as Barry Louis Polisar (Juno movie) and Ed King (Lynyrd Skynyrd). He founded Ambient Recording in 1980 and actively gigs with small combos and in church. He has released 3 CD projects of original material. Andy Hamburger (Drums, percussion). Andy is one of the busiest working drummers in the Washington D.C area. Amy Grant Wolfe (Artistic Director) Born in Buffalo, New York, Ms. Wolfe has a B.A. degree in Theater (Summa cum Laude) from Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio and a M.F.A. in Dance from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX where she twice received the Meadows Award as an outstanding dance student, and won the Betty Ferguson Award as Outstanding Graduate student. As a professional dancer, Ms. Wolfe was a soloist with Ballet Dallas, Ballet Midland, Irving Ballet, Richardson Ballet, Dallas Metropolitan Ballet, Southwest Dance Collective, and Berea Summer Theatre. After moving

to Manassas in 1990, Ms. Wolfe became a teacher at the Manassas School of Dance (now MBA) and a principal dancer with Manassas Dance Company (now MBT). In 1997, Ms. Wolfe became Associate Director of MBT and helped lead the expansion of the Company into a professional ballet company. In 1999, she became Artistic Director of Manassas Ballet Theatre. In 2008, Ms. Wolfe was presented with the Seefeldt Pioneer Award for Arts Excellence by the Prince William County Park Authority Arts Council for her contributions to the areas art community. Under her leadership, MBT has become the largest performing arts organization in Northern Virginia.

Vadim Slatvitskiy (Ballet Master, Choreographer, Dr. Van Halsing) After graduating in 1989 from the Novosibirsk Ballet Academy in Russia, Mr. Slatvitskiy became the principal dancer with the Novosibirsk Theatre from 1989 until 2000 where he danced in many productions. In 2000, he became a principal dancer with the Grigorovich Ballet Company in Russia. He has also appeared as a guest dancer across the United States. He has danced the principal roles in The Nutcracker, Giselle, La Fille Mal Gardee, Don Quixote, Frankenstein and Cinderella just to name a few. Mr. Slatvitskiy has toured



around the world, including countries such as Argentina, China, Egypt, England, Germany and Italy. Mr. Slatvitskiy serves as primary choreographer, ballet master, and principal dancer for Manassas Ballet Theatre as well as a principal teacher and Youth American Grand Prix coach for Manassas Ballet Academy. Mr. Slatvitskiy joined MBT in 2006.



Joshua Burnham (Ballet Master, Jonathan Harker) Mr. Burnham was born in Lake Tahoe, CA and started his ballet training at Santa Cruz Ballet under the direction of Robert Kelly and Diane Cypher. He continued his training in Washington at Mid-Columbia Ballet under Debra Rogo. At age 13, he received full scholarships to San Francisco Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, Pacific Northwest Ballet, and Houston Ballet. In 2004, he joined San Francisco Ballet where he performed in such ballets as Helgi Tomasson's Meiston's Mozart, and Balanchine's Stars and Stripes and The Four

Temperments. In 2006, Mr. Burnham joined Cincinnati Ballet where he danced many lead roles. He has worked with choreographers Jorma Elo, Val Caniparoli, Mark Morris, Trey McIntyre, James Kudelka, and Twyla Tharp. In 2009-2011, he performed with Ballet Theatre of Maryland dancing as Romeo in Romeo and Juliet and the Cavalier in The Nutcracker among other roles. Mr. Burnham joined MBT in 2012. He is also a teacher and YAGP coach for Manassas Ballet Academy.

Ahmed Nabil (Assistant Ballet Master, Quincy Morris) Originally from Egypt, Mr. Nabil graduated from the Higher Institute of Ballet, Academy of Arts, and then received his Bachelor's Degree in Choreography. He received several awards, including First Prize twice in the Classical Ballet Competition at the Egyptian Ministry of Culture. Mr. Nabil was a principal dancer with the Cairo Opera House where he danced many leading roles including Siegfried in Swan Lake, Basilio in Don Ouixote, Romeo in Romeo and Juliet, to name a few. He was named the Assistant Director for the Cairo Opera Ballet Company

in 2012. His Ballet, Exit Door, won the Critics Award as a Best Ballet in 2014. Mr. Nabil became co-proprietor and Artistic Director of Columbia Youth Ballet in Maryland in 2019. Mr. Nabil joined MBT in 2018 and the MBA faculty in 2020. He is the Assistant Ballet Master, a choreographer, and dancer for MBT and teacher for MBA.

Ruslan Amrayev (Lord Arthur Holmwood) Mr. Amrayev was born in Almaty, Kazakhstan, and received his ballet training from A. Seleznev Choreographic School of Almaty from 1996 until 2004. After graduating with honors from the school, he was a principal dancer with the National Opera and Ballet House in Almaty from 2004 until 2013, where he danced in many productions including Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, Badhchisarai Fountain, Taras Bulba, and Legend of Love. Mr. Amrayev then danced in the Russian National Ballet of Sergey and Elena Radchenko from 2013 until 2014. Currently, he is working as an impresario and organizer with the Alan Bars



Group, the largest production company in Kazakhstan. The company hosts the most signifigant and important concerts and ballet festivals inside the country as well as the international arena.



Victoria Bartlett (Vampire Wife) Ms. Bartlett is a Maryland native and a 2016 graduate of Goucher College in Baltimore, where she finished Magna Cum Laude with a BA in dance and minor in psychology. Ms. Bartlett spent the 2016-17 season with Charlottesville Ballet as trainee, where she danced several corps de ballet roles, including *The Nutcracker*'s Waltz of the Flowers. She was invited as guest artist by Howard County Ballet in 2013-2015 to dance Sugar Plum Fairy. Ms. Bartlett received the majority of her training at de Glen Burnie, MD's Edna Lee Dance Studio, where she eventually taught

ballet, pointe, jazz and contemporary/lyrical as well as choreographed for the school. Ms. Bartlett joined MBT in 2017 and the MBA faculty in 2019.

Alice De Nardi (Bat, Gypsy) Originally from Italy, Ms. De Nardi began the study of ballet at the age of 6 at Academy Teatro alla Scala di Milano in Milan, Italy. She graduated from the Ukrainian Academy of Ballet of Kiev in 2012. In June 2005, Ms. De Nardi received a scholarship for the Royal Ballet School in London, and in 2010, participated at the International competition of Opera Kiev in Ukraine. In 2011, she toured Europe with the Royal Czech Ballet Company performing as a soloist in Giselle. After graduation, Ms. De Nardi danced with the Macedonian Opera and Ballet as

a soloist in Skopje and touring to different European cities. In 2015, she joined the Cairo Opera House as a First Soloist. Also in 2015, Ms. De Nardi participated at the Domenico Modugno competition at the Petruzzelli Theater in Italy and placed in the top 10. She became coproprietor and Artistic Director of Columbia Youth Ballet in Maryland in 2019 and a coach for YAGP in 2020 winning 2nd place. Ms. De Nardi joined the Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2018.



Chelsea Endris (Lucy) Ms. Endris began her training at Southern Indiana School for the Arts, where she studied ballet, jazz, theatre and voice. She graduated from Point Park University with a BFA in Dance. She performed in masterfuls works by Choreographers Matthew Powell, Septime Weber and Anthony Tudor among others. In 2017-18, she served as an Apprentice with the Montgomery Ballet. Ms. Endris joined MBT in 2018.

Davia Ford (Bat, Gypsy) Ms. Ford of Struthers, Ohio is a classical ballet dancer with additional training in modern,

jazz, and tap. She began her training at the age of 7 at Ballet Western Reserve and continued until she was 18 performing a variety of roles from The Nutcracker, Sleeping Beauty, and The Wizard of Oz. Ms. Ford has also trained at the Cleveland Ballet with Gladisa Guadalupé while attending their summer program. Upon graduation in 2017 she continued her training at Mercyhurst University to receive a B.F.A. in Dance Performance as well as an



Art Minor. While attending Mercyhurst, she performed a variety of classical and contemporary works with The Mercyhurst Dancers as well as choreographing some of her own. This is Ms. Ford's first season with MBT.

> Kaitlin Frankenfield (Vampire Wife) Ms. Frankenfield began her training with Kathryn Stout in her hometown of Easton, PA. She attended summer programs at the Pennsylvania Youth Ballet, Joffrey Ballet School and American Ballet Theatre. Ms. Frankenfield graduated with honors from the high school

program at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts where she had the opportunity to perform with American Ballet Theatre's second company. She is a magna cum laude graduate of the University of Cincinnati's College- Conservatory of Music with a BFA in ballet and a minor in English. Ms. Frankenfield performed professionally with Ballet Theatre Midwest and Kentucky Ballet Theatre during her studies. After graduation, she was a soloist with Ballet Theatre of Maryland and a guest artist with the Baltimore Ballet. The highlights of Ms. Frankenfield's repertoire with MBT include the Sugar Plum Fairy in the Nutcracker, Giselle, Aurora in Sleeping Beauty, Cinderella and Juliet in Romeo and Juliet. Frankenfield joined MBT and the MBA faculty in 2014.


Debora Greer (Featured Gypsy, Bat) Originally from Brazil, Ms. Greer started dancing at the age of twelve. In Sao Paulo, she joined Renata Reys "Produdoes e Eventos" for two years as a dancer and taught ballet classes, as well. Ms. Greer first came to the United States for a summer intensive at Ballet Chicago in 2012, then studied on a full scholarship in the yearround program with Chicago Ballet Arts. In 2014, she began studying at the Joffrey Ballet School in New York as a ballet trainee for two years, dancing as a guest artist with Eglevsky Ballet for "The Nutcracker" in



2015 with Homo Veritas Dance Theatre in 2016. She studied with Mrs. Ashley Tuttle during the summer of 2016. Ms. Greer attended Nashville Ballet Summer Intensive for Professional Dancers in 2019 with a partial scholarship, and she was a weekly winner of New York Dance Project quarantine choreography contest 2020. Ms. Greer joined MBT in 2016 and joined the MBA faculty in 2017. She is also a choreographer for MBT.

Emily Haman (Bat, Gypsy) Ms. Haman, from Cary, North Carolina, trained at The Triangle Academy of Dance under the direction of Margaret Severin-Hansen and Annette Hagopian. She was a member of Carolina Youth Ballet where she performed numerous ballets and has had featured roles. Ms. Haman has been a part of the Pre Professional Trainee Program at Triangle Academy of Dance since 2017 and joined their Professional Trainee Program in 2020. This is Ms. Haman's first season with MBT.

in Tokyo, Japan. He began his ballet training at Kamiya Ballet Art. Later he continued his studies at K-Ballet School and The Rock School for Dance Education. Mr. Kaneko has danced professionally with Alberta Ballet II, Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida and Virginia National Ballet. In addition, he has performed as a guest dancer at various prestigious venues in Japan. Mr. Kaneko has won various prizes in Japanese national competitions such as the 50th Saitama Ballet Competition 2017 and the Nagoya National Ballet Competition 2016 and 2017 where he won first place. Mr. Kaneko joined MBT in 2020.





Hannah Locke (Mina) Ms. Locke, from Chattanooga, TN, began her s scholarship at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts under the direction of Ethan Stiefel. She attended summer intensives at Ballet Tennessee, Joffrey Midwest. American Pollet The Tennessee, Joffrey Midwest, American Ballet Theatre, Kaatsbaan and Boston Ballet. Ms. Locke began her professional career as a trainee with Richmond Ballet, and later served as Principal Dancer and Ballet Administrator at Ballet Tennessee. Ms. Locke has performed a variety of featured roles with MBT

including Snow Queen in The Nutcracker, Myrtha in Giselle, and the Mazurka in Les Sylphides. She joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2018 and is also an instructor at Manassas Ballet Academy and a Publicity and Marketing Assistant with MBT.

Kurumi Miwa (Bat, Gypsy) Ms. Miwa, from Tokyo, began her ballet training at age 3. At 19 years old, she was awarded a merit scholarship to continue her training at the Joffrey School of Ballet in New York under the direction of Era Jouravley. At Joffrey. Ms. Miwa danced the role of Juliet in



Romeo and Juliet and was a principal dancer in Naina's Magic Garden. Ms. Miwa also trained with the Central School of Ballet in London, the Royal Danish Ballet, Milwaukee Ballet, Oklahoma City Ballet and Maryland Youth Ballet. In 2018, Ms. Miwa won 1st place at the Japan Ballet Competition as well as the Technical Award and a Special Judges award.
