#### Act I: The Garden of the Palace

Prince Siegfried is celebrating his 21st birthday. Because he loves to hunt, his mother gives him a crossbow as his birthday present. She reminds him that tomorrow, at the formal celebration of his coming of age, he must choose a suitable bride. Sensing the responsibilities that he has ahead, Prince Siegfried decides to go hunting to take his mind off his worries. He catches sight of a flock of white swans and goes off into the forest.

#### Act II: A Forest Lake at Dusk

Prince Siegfried arrives at a lake, in pursuit of the swans. As the sun is setting and he draws his bow to shoot, a swan turns into a beautiful young woman. She tells him her name is Odette, and she is the queen of the swans. She tells Prince Siegfried that Rothbart, an evil sorcerer, has turned her and the other maidens into swans, and they can only take their human form at night. The only way the spell can be broken is if a man, pure in heart, pledges to love her. Prince Siegfried tries to capture Odette, but she disappears into the midst of the swan maidens. He pursues Odette and vows eternal love and fidelity to her. As dawn breaks, Odette bids him farewell, and the white swans glide slowly away across the lake.

### \*\*\*INTERMISSION\*\*\*

#### Act III: The Palace Ball

Prince Siegfried must choose a bride from among the women who have been invited to the ball. Although he is indifferent to them all, he must choose one by giving her a bouquet of flowers. As the pressure mounts, a trumpet fanfare heralds the arrival of Rothbart and his daughter, Odile whom he has transformed to look like Odette. Prince Siegfried is spellbound by Odile's resemblance to Odette. Rothbart's goal is for Prince Siegfried to fall in love with Odile, and thus break his vow to Odette, causing her to remain a swan forever. Odile seduces Prince Siegfried, who is fascinated by her charm. He announces to his mother that Odile is his choice, and Rothbart is jubilant in victory. Suddenly, Prince Siegfried sees Odette outside the castle window and realizes that he has broken his vow. He rushes to the lake to find her.

### Act IV: The Lakeside at Night

The swan maidens are heartbroken when Odette tells them what happened. An enraged Rothbart arrives, and attacks Odette. Thinking he has killed her, he departs. Prince Siegfried rushes in, and seeing Odette, begs her to forgive him. Just then, Rothbart reappears and begins fighting Prince Siegfried, nearly beating him. Odette intervenes to save her Prince, and Rothbart falls to his death. The spell is broken by Rothbart's death, and the rising sun shines on all the maidens, Odette, and Prince Siegfried.

#### BIOGRAPHIES



Amy Grant Wolfe (Artistic Director, Choreographer) Born in Buffalo, New York, Ms. Wolfe has a B.A. degree in Theater (Summa cum Laude) from Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio and a M.F.A. in Dance from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX where she twice received the Meadows Award as an outstanding dance student and won the Betty Ferguson Award as Outstanding Graduate student. As a professional 💆 dancer, Ms. Wolfe was a soloist with Ballet Dallas, Ballet Midland, Irving

Ballet, Richardson Ballet, Dallas Metropolitan Ballet, Southwest Dance Collective, and Berea Summer Theatre. After moving to Manassas in 1990, Ms. Wolfe became a teacher at the Manassas School of Dance (now MBA) and a principal dancer with Manassas Dance Company (now MBT). In 1997, Ms. Wolfe became Associate Director of Manassas Ballet Theatre and helped lead the expansion of the Company into a professional ballet company. In 1999, she became Artistic Director of Manassas Ballet Theatre. In 2008, Ms. Wolfe was presented with the Seefeldt Pioneer Award for Arts Excellence by the Prince William County Park Authority Arts Council for her contributions to the area's art community. Under her leadership, MBT has become the largest performing arts organization in Northern Virginia.

Christopher Hite (Music Director) Mr. Hite has served as conductor for performances with the Manassas Ballet Theatre since 1997. In 1999, he became Music Director of the Company. Mr. Hite has conducted numerous ensembles in concert throughout the Washington area, including The National Gallery Orchestra, The Prince William Symphony Orchestra, Wind Works Chamber Ensemble, and The U.S. Air Force Band. A native of Columbus, Ohio, Mr. Hite holds degrees in music from Capital



University and The Catholic University of America. In 1994, he was invited to participate in The Conductor's Institute at the University of South Carolina and has also conducted workshops held by The Conductor's Guild of America, working with such notable artists as Yoel Levi, Paul Vermel, Lawrence Leighton Smith, Donald Portnoy, and others. Mr. Hite is the founder and Music Director of the Dominion Symphony Orchestra, which held its inaugural performance in May 2008. He is married to flutist Angela Uperti-Hite.



Vadim Slatvitskiy (Ballet Master, Choreographer, Friend) After graduating in 1989 from the Novosibirsk Ballet Academy in Russia, Mr. Slatvitskiy became the principal dancer with the Novosibirsk Theatre from 1989 until 2000 where he danced in many productions. In 2000, he became a principal dancer with the Grigorovich Ballet Company in Russia. He has also appeared as a guest dancer across the United States. He has danced the principal roles in The Nutcracker, Giselle, La Fille Mal Gardee,

Don Quixote, Frankenstein and Cinderella just to name a few. Mr. Slatvitskiy has toured around the world, including countries such as Argentina, China, Egypt, England, Germany and Italy. Mr. Slatvitskiy serves as primary choreographer, ballet master, and principal dancer for Manassas Ballet Theatre as well as a principal teacher and Youth American Grand Prix coach for Manassas Ballet Academy. Mr. Slatvitskiy joined MBT in 2006.

Joshua Burnham (Ballet Master, Prince Siegfried, Spanish) Mr. Burnham was born in Lake Tahoe, CA and started his ballet training at Santa Cruz Ballet under the direction of Robert Kelly and Diane Cypher. He continued his training in Washington at Mid-Columbia Ballet under Debra Rogo. At age 13, he received full scholarships to San Francisco Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, Pacific Northwest Ballet, and Houston Ballet. In 2004, he joined San Francisco Ballet where he performed in such ballets as Helgi



Tomasson's Meiston's Mozart, and Balanchine's Stars and Stripes and The Four

Temperments. In 2006, Mr. Burnham joined Cincinnati Ballet where he danced in many lead roles. He has worked with choreographers Jorma Elo, Val Caniparoli, Mark Morris, Trey McIntyre, James Kudelka, and Twyla Tharp. In 2009-2011, he performed with Ballet Theatre of Maryland dancing as Romeo in Romeo and Juliet and the Cavalier in The Nutcracker among other roles. Mr. Burnham joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2012. He is also a teacher and YAGP coach for Manassas Ballet Academy.

Ballet, Academy of Arts, and then received his Bachelor's Degree in Choreography. He received several awards, including First Prize twice in the Classical Ballet Competition at the Egyptian Ministry of Culture. Mr. Nabil was a principal dancer with the Cairo Opera House where he danced many leading roles including Siegfried in Swan Lake, Basilio in Don Quixote, Romeo in Romeo and Juliet, to name a few. He was named the Assistant Director for the Cairo Opera Ballet Company in 2012. His Ballet, Exit Door, won the Critics Award as a Best Ballet in 2014. Mr. Nabil became co-proprietor and Artistic Director of Columbia Youth

Ballet in Maryland in 2019. Mr. Nabil joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2018. In 2022 his choreography won second place at Youth America Grand Prix. He is the Assistant Ballet Master, a choreographer, and dancer for MBT and teacher for Manassas Ballet Academy.

Ahmed Nabil (Assistant Ballet Master, Rothbart, Friend, Mazurka) Originally from Egypt, Mr. Nabil graduated from the Higher Institute of



Emily Abrom (Friend, Swan, Bride, Mazurka) From Lancaster, Pennsylvania, Ms. Abrom is an experienced professional dancer. Her career includes dancing for four years with the Novosibirsk State Opera and Ballet Theater and two years with the Mariinsky Theater, Primorsky Stage (Vladivostok). In addition, with the Arrondi Art Ballet and Brussels International Ballet, Ms. Abrom has toured in South Korea, China, Moscow, St. Petersburg, Crimea, Italy, Germany, Switzerland and Austria.

Her training includes Paris Opera, Danish Royal Ballet, Houston Ballet, American Ballet Theater, Polish National Ballet and Bolshoi Ballet. Ms. Abrom is also an off-Broadway actress and singer who has performed in over 20 musical theater productions. This is Ms. Abrom's first production with MBT.

Gabriela Antuñano (Friend, Swan, Vision of Odette) Originally from Monterrey, Mexico, Ms. Antuñano started dancing at age 3. She danced jazz, tap, hip-hop, ballet, salsa, lyrical and contemporary. In 2018 she completed her ballet training at the Escuela Ballet de Monterrey. Ms. Antuñano is a 2020 Magna Cum Laude graduate from South Texas College with a

Bachelor of Applied Sciences degree in Organizational Leadership. She won 1st place in the Starpower, Organizacion Juvenil de Danza and Interprepas Tec de Monterrey competitions and was a finalist at the World Ballet Competition. Ms. Antuñano previously danced with Ballet de Monterrey. This is Ms. Antuñano first production with MBT.



Ruslan Amrayev (Friend, Hungarian) Mr. Amrayev was born in Almaty, Kazakhstan, and received his ballet training from A. Seleznev Choreographic School of Almaty from 1996 until 2004. After graduating with honors from the school, he was a principal dancer with the National Opera and Ballet House in Almaty from 2004 until 2013, where he danced in many productions including Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, Badhchisarai

Fountain, Taras Bulba, and Legend of Love. Mr. Amrayev then danced in the Russian National Ballet of Sergey and Elena Radchenko from 2013 until 2014. Currently, he is working as an impresario and organizer with the Alan Bars Group, the largest production company in Kazakhstan. The company hosts the most significant and important concerts and ballet festivals inside the country as well as the international arena. Mr. Amrayev joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2014.

Carlos Quezada

Victoria Bartlett (Friend, Little Swan, Bride, Neapolitan) Ms. Bartlett is a Maryland native and a 2016 graduate of Goucher College in Baltimore, where she finished Magna Cum Laude with a BA in dance and minor in psychology. Ms. Bartlett received a majority of her training at Glen Burnie, Maryland's, Edna Lee Dance Studio, where she eventually taught ballet, pointe, jazz and contemporary/lyrical as well as choreographed dances for the school. She was invited as guest artist by Howard County Ballet in



2013-2015 to dance Sugar Plum Fairy. Ms. Bartlett spent the 2016-17 season with Charlottesville Ballet as trainee and danced several corps de ballet roles, including *The Nutcracker*'s Waltz of the Flowers. She has danced many roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Lucy and a Vampire Wife in Dracula, Arabian and Lead Flower in the Nutcracker, and a Stepsister in Cinderella. Ms. Bartlett joined MBT in 2017 and the Manassas Ballet Academy faculty in 2019.



Pavel Bochkovsky (Jester, Friend, Neapolitan) Mr. Bochkovsky is from Novosibirsk, Russia where he studied at the Novosibirsk State Choreographic School. He joined Nizhny Novgorod Pushkin State Theater and the Russian National Ballet. Mr. Bochkovsky danced with the Mariinsky Theatre in Vlasivostok, the Yuri Grigorovich Ballet Theatre. He most recently worked for the Musical Theatre of the Republic of Karelia and the Nizhny Novgrorod Pushkin State Theatre. This is Mr.

Bochkovsky's first season with Manassas Ballet Theatre.

Annemieke Bruce (Friend, Little Swan, Neapolitan, Hungarian) Born in Los Angeles, Ms. Bruce began her training with Maria Whaley in Ashland, Kentucky. She continued her training, graduating from The Kirov Academy of Ballet in Washington DC. As a professional, Ms. Bruce worked with the Classical Ballet in Charleston, SC, Ballet 5:8 in Chicago and Virginia National Ballet. From 2018 to 2022 She danced with the State Opera Stara Zagora in Bulgaria. This is Ms. Bruce's first season with MBT.

Originally from Italy, Ms. De Nardi began the study of ballet at the age of six at Academy Teatro alla Scala di Milano in Milan, Italy. She graduated from the Ukrainian Academy of Ballet of Kyiv in 2012. In June 2005, Ms. De Nardi received a scholarship for the Royal Ballet School in London, and in 2010, participated at the International Competition of Opera Kyiv in Ukraine. In 2011, she toured Europe with the Royal

Czech Ballet Company performing as a soloist in Giselle. After graduation, Ms. De Nardi toured Europe with the Macedonian Opera and Ballet as a soloist in Skopje. In 2015, she joined the Cairo Opera House as a First Soloist and participated at the Domenico Modugno competition at the Petruzzelli Theater in Italy where she placed in the top five. She became co-proprietor and Artistic Director of Columbia Youth Ballet in Maryland in 2019 and a coach for YAGP in 2020 and 2022 winning 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Ms. De Nardi joined the Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2018.

Abigail Gorrell (Friend, Big Swan, Bride, Mazurka) Ms. Gorrell is from Manassas, Virginia. She began dancing at the age of five and is a recent graduate of Manassas Ballet Academy. She was a regular participant in Youth America Grand Prix, and attended summer intensives with The School of Pennsylvania Ballet. As a student, Ms. Gorrell has performed various roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Clara in Nutcracker. This is Ms. Gorrell's first season with MBT.



Debora Greer (Friend, Big Swan, Bride, Mazurka) Originally from Brazil, Ms. Greer started dancing at the age of 12. In Sao Paulo, she joined Renata Reys "Produdoes e Eventos" for two years as a dancer and taught ballet classes. Ms. Greer first came to the United States for a summer intensive at Ballet Chicago in 2012, then studied on a full scholarship in the year-round program with Chicago Ballet Arts. In 2014, she began studying at the र्डै Joffrey Ballet School in New York as a ballet trainee for two years. Ms. Greer
