They play a game of capture the flag, but Colin gets his feelings hurt. Amy tries to comfort him and soon it is time for Friday night Sabbath prayers.

Scene 2: Manassas, Virginia - Summer, 2001 14 year old Colin is playing with his friends . . .

Scene 3: Manassas, Virginia - Summer, 2001 They are joined by 10 year old Cece and her friends.

Scene 4: The morning of September 11, 2001

Scene 5: Colin's Decision: "I will be a Marine."

# Act II

Scene 1: Normandy, France - May 2005 Omaha Beach and the American Cemetery

During a family trip, in honor of Colin's upcoming high school graduation, Colin and Cece are looking at monuments when they are joined by Amy and Mark.

# Scene 2: Paris, France - Later that night

Colin feels lonely and restless. He wants to go for a walk, but Cece wants to tag along. He slips away and wanders into a jazz club.

# Scene 3: Parris Island, South Carolina – July 2005

Colin begins his Marine training.

# Scene 4: Manassas, Virginia - June 2006

Kira Wolf walks alone, longing for that special someone.

# Scene 5: Manassas, Virginia June 9, 2006

Colin and Kira meet and fall in love, but Colin is due to be deployed to Iraq.

# Scene 6: Habbaniyah, Iraq - August 2006

The Marines of 3/2 are training, patrolling, and sometimes resting.

# Scene 7: Habbaniyah, Iraq - The morning of August 30, 2006

Colin volunteers for patrol when not enough Marines are available due to the many casualties suffered despite the fact that he had been on a patrol the previous night. He is killed in action when a roadside bomb explodes underneath the vehicle he is riding in.

# Scene 8: Manassas, Virginia - August 31, 2006

Amy, Mark, Cece, and Kira together with all their friends and family, and Colin's fellow Marines react to the news of Colin's death.

# Epilogue: Arlington National Cemetery

Veterans Day, November 11, 2023

As so many times during the year, every year, Amy and Mark bring flowers to Colin's grave.

# **BIOGRAPHIES**



Amy Grant Wolfe (Artistic Director, Choreographer) Born in Buffalo, New York, Ms. Wolfe has a B.A. degree in Theater (Summa cum Laude) from Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio and a M.F.A. in Dance from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX where she twice received the Meadows Award as an outstanding dance student and won the Betty Ferguson Award as Outstanding Graduate student. As a professional dancer, Ms. Wolfe was a soloist with Ballet Dallas, Ballet

Midland, Irving Ballet, Richardson Ballet, Dallas Metropolitan Ballet, Southwest Dance Collective, and Berea Summer Theatre. After moving to Manassas in 1990, Ms. Wolfe became a teacher at the Manassas School of Dance (now MBA) and a principal dancer with Manassas Dance Company (now MBT). In 1997, Ms. Wolfe became Associate Director of Manassas Ballet Theatre and helped lead the expansion of the Company into a professional ballet company. In 1999, she became Artistic Director of Manassas Ballet Theatre. In 2008, Ms. Wolfe was presented with the Seefeldt Pioneer Award for Arts Excellence by the Prince William County Park Authority Arts Council for her contributions to the area's art community. Under her leadership, MBT has become the largest performing arts organization in Northern Virginia.

Mark Menza (Composer) Mr. Menza is a composer arranger based out of Dallas, Texas. His company Menza Music was founded in 1994 with a focus on scoring to picture, and sound design, for all types of media. Mr. Menza was born and raised in Buffalo, New York. He attended Sweet Home Senior High School where he met Amy Grant Wolfe. He received a BA from SUNY Fredonia and graduate work at The

University of North Texas. Mark composed the music for Wolfe's master's thesis at Southern Methodist University in 1981. He also provided original music for a short jazz dance that was performed at MBT's premier performance in 1999, when Amy first became the Artistic Director. His composition for Colin began as a 20-minute, one act piece. The full length 72-minute version COLIN: Son, Marine, Hero premiered in 2014. Mark has worked on the animated franchise Jimmy Neutron the motion picture (Paramount, Nickelodeon films) and The Adventures of Jimmy Neutron TV series as a post supervisor; The Ant Bully Feature (Warner Bros.), Dragon Ball GT and Wishbone (PBS). In 2021 he scored Negotiating Dialogues, a five movement generative chamber piece with visual projections as part of the Dallas Symphony's Soluna. Festival. Additionally, he has scored numerous films, documentaries, games, episodic TV, as well as a spectrum of commercials, and branded content. Mark is also a sound designer and audio post mixer for many independent features, short films, and broadcast work.



Christopher Hite (Music Director) Mr. Hite has served as conductor for performances with the Manassas Ballet Theatre since 1997. In 1999, he became Music Director of the Company. Mr. Hite has conducted numerous ensembles in concert throughout the Washington area, including The National Gallery Orchestra, The Prince William Symphony Orchestra, Wind Works Chamber Ensemble, and The U.S. Air Force Band. A native of Columbus, Ohio, Mr. Hite holds degrees in

music from Capital University and The Catholic University of America. In 1994, he was invited to participate in The Conductor's Institute at the University of South Carolina

and has also conducted workshops held by The Conductor's Guild of America, working with such notable artists as Yoel Levi, Paul Vermel, Lawrence Leighton Smith, Donald Portnoy, and others. Mr. Hite is the founder and Music Director of the Dominion Symphony Orchestra, which held its inaugural performance in May 2008.

Vadim Slatvitskiy (Ballet Master, Mark) After graduating in 1989 from the Novosibirsk Ballet Academy in Russia, Mr. Slatvitskiy became the principal dancer with the Novosibirsk Theatre from 1989 until 2000 where he danced in many productions. In 2000, he became a principal dancer with the Grigorovich Ballet Company in Russia. He has also appeared as a guest dancer across the United States. He has danced the principal roles in The Nutcracker, Giselle, La Fille Mal Gardee, Don



Quixote, Frankenstein and Cinderella just to name a few. Mr. Slatvitskiy has toured around the world, including countries such as Argentina, China, Egypt, England, Germany and Italy. Mr. Slatvitskiy serves as primary choreographer, ballet master, and dancer for Manassas Ballet Theatre as well as a teacher for Manassas Ballet Academy. Mr. Slatvitskiy joined MBT in 2006.

Joshua Burnham (Ballet Master, Colin) Mr. Burnham was born in Lake Tahoe, CA and started his ballet training at Santa Cruz Ballet under the direction of Robert Kelly and Diane Cypher. He continued his training in Washington at Mid-Columbia Ballet under Debra Rogo. At age 13, he received full scholarships to San Francisco Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, Pacific Northwest Ballet, and Houston Ballet. In 2004, he joined San



Francisco Ballet where he performed in such ballets as Helgi Tomasson's Meiston's Mozart, and Balanchine's Stars and Stripes and The Four Temperments. In 2006, Mr. Burnham joined Cincinnati Ballet where he danced in many lead roles. He has worked with choreographers Jorma Elo, Val Caniparoli, Mark Morris, Trey McIntyre, James Kudelka, and Twyla Tharp. In 2009-2011, he performed with Ballet Theatre of Maryland dancing as Romeo in Romeo and Juliet and the Cavalier in The Nutcracker among other roles. Mr. Burnham joined MBT in 2012. He is also a teacher, YAGP coach, and a director of the Manassas Youth Ballet for Manassas Ballet Academy.



Ahmed Nabil (Assistant Ballet Master, Friend, Jazz Club Patron, Marine Commander) Originally from Egypt, Mr. Nabil graduated from the Higher Institute of Ballet, Academy of Arts, and then received his bachelor's degree in Choreography. He received several awards, including First Prize twice in the Classical Ballet Competition at the Egyptian Ministry of Culture. Mr. Nabil was a principal dancer with the Cairo Opera House lễ where he danced many leading roles including Siegfried in *Swan Lake*,

Basilio in Don Quixote, Romeo in Romeo and Juliet, to name a few. He was named the Assistant Director for the Cairo Opera Ballet Company in 2012. His Ballet, Exit Door, won the Critics Award as a Best Ballet in 2014. Mr. Nabil became co-proprietor and Artistic Director of Columbia Youth Ballet in Maryland in 2019. Mr. Nabil joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2018. In 2022 his choreography won second place at YAGP. He is the Assistant Ballet Master, a choreographer, and dancer for MBT and teacher for Manassas Ballet Academy.

Emily Abrom (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) From Lancaster, Pennsylvania, Ms. Abrom is an experienced professional dancer. Her career includes dancing for four years with the Novosibirsk State Opera and Ballet Theater and two years with the Mariinsky Theater, Primorsky Stage (Vladivostok). In addition, with the Arrondi Art Ballet and Brussels International Ballet, Ms. Abrom has toured in South Korea, China, Moscow, St. Petersburg, Crimea, Italy, Germany, Switzerland and Austria. Her training includes Paris Opera, Danish Royal Ballet, Houston Ballet, American Ballet Theater, Polish National Ballet and Bo



Houston Ballet, American Ballet Theater, Polish National Ballet and Bolshoi Ballet. Ms. Abrom is also an off-Broadway actress and singer who has performed in over 20 musical theater productions. Ms. Abrom joined MBT in 2023.



Gabriela Antuñano (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Originally from Monterrey, Mexico, Ms. Antuñano started dancing at age 3. She danced jazz, tap, hip-hop, ballet, salsa, lyrical and contemporary. In 2018 she completed her ballet training at the Escuela Ballet de Monterrey. Ms. Antuñano is a 2020 Magna Cum Laude graduate from South Texas College with a Bachelor of Applied Sciences degree in Organizational

Leadership. She won 1st place in the Starpower, Organizacion Juvenil de Danza and Interprepas Tec de Monterrey competitions and was a finalist at the World Ballet Competition. Ms. Antuñano previously danced with Ballet de Monterrey. Ms. Antuñano joined MBT in 2023.

Victoria Bartlett (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Ms. Bartlett is a Maryland native and a 2016 graduate of Goucher College in Baltimore, where she finished Magna Cum Laude with a BA in dance and minor in psychology. Ms. Bartlett received a majority of her training at Glen Burnie, Maryland's, Edna Lee Dance Studio, where she eventually taught ballet, pointe, jazz and contemporary/lyrical as well as choreographed dances for

the school. She was invited as guest artist by Howard County Ballet in 2013-2015 to dance Sugar Plum Fairy. Ms. Bartlett spent the 2016-17 season with Charlottesville Ballet as trainee and danced several corps de ballet roles, including *The Nutcracker*'s Waltz of the Flowers. She has danced many roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Lucy and a Vampire Wife in Dracula, Arabian and Lead Flower in the Nutcracker, and a Stepsister in Cinderella. Ms. Bartlett joined MBT in 2017. She is also a teacher and YAGP coach for Manassas Ballet Academy.



Pavel Bochkovsky (Friend, Jazz Club Patron, Marine) Mr. Bochkovsky is from Novosibirsk, Russia where he studied at the Novosibirsk State Choreographic School. He joined Nizhny Novgorod Pushkin State Theater and the Russian National Ballet. Mr. Bochkovsky danced with the Mariinsky Theatre in Vlasivostok, the Yuri Grigorovich Ballet Theatre. He most recently worked for the Musical Theatre of the

Republic of Karelia and the Nizhny Novgrorod Pushkin State Theatre. Mr. Bochkovsky joined MBT in 2022.

Annemieke Bruce (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Born in Los Angeles, Ms. Bruce began her training with Maria Whaley in Ashland, Kentucky. She continued her training, graduating from The Kirov



Academy of Ballet in Washington DC. As a professional, Ms. Bruce worked with the Classical Ballet in Charleston, SC, Ballet 5:8 in Chicago and Virginia National Ballet. From 2018 to 2022 She danced with the State Opera Stara Zagora in Bulgaria. Ms. Bruce joined MBT in 2022.

Adeline Campbell Prest (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Ms. Campbell Prest is from Canada. After training that includes Royal Winnipeg Ballet and Central Pennsylvania Ballet she danced with the De La Dance Company of Cincinnati. Ms. Campbell Prest joined MBT in 2023.

Alice De Nardi (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Originally from Italy, Ms. De Nardi began the study of ballet at the age of six

at Academy Teatro alla Scala di Milano in Milan, Italy. She graduated from the Ukrainian Academy of Ballet of Kyiv in 2012. In June 2005, Ms. De

Nardi received a scholarship for the Royal Ballet School in London, and in 2010, participated at the International Competition of Opera Kyiv in Ukraine. In 2011, she toured Europe with the Royal Czech Ballet Company performing as a soloist in Giselle. After graduation, Ms. De Nardi toured Europe with the Macedonian Opera and Ballet as a soloist in Skopje. In 2015, she joined the Cairo Opera House as a First Soloist and participated at the Domenico Modugno competition at the Petruzzelli Theater in Italy where she placed in the top five. She became co-proprietor and Artistic Director of Columbia Youth Ballet in Maryland in 2019 and a coach for YAGP in 2020 and 2022 winning 2<sup>nd</sup> place.



Ms. De Nardi joined MBT in 2018.

Abigail Gorrell (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Ms. Gorrell is from Manassas, Virginia. She began dancing at the age of five and graduated from Manassas Ballet Academy in 2022. She competed in Youth America Grand Prix, and attended summer intensives with The School of Pennsylvania Ballet. As a student, Ms. Gorrell performed various roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Clara in Nutcracker. Ms. Gorrell joined MBT 2022.

Eliza Hedlund (Friend) Ms. Hedlund grew up in Northern Virginia and has studied at many local ballet schools including Adagio Ballet, Seber Method Academy, Washington Ballet, and the Cuppett Performing Arts Center. Ms. Hedlund also attended the Bolshoi Ballet summer intensive and Virginia Governor's school for additional training and currently teaches ballet at the Herndon Community Center. This is Ms. Hedlund's first season with MBT.

Masaya Kaneko Friend, Jazz Club Patron, Marine) Mr. Kaneko was born in Tokyo, Japan. He began his ballet training at Kamiya Ballet Art. Later he continued his studies at K-Ballet School and The Rock School for Dance Education. Mr. Kaneko has danced professionally with Alberta Ballet II, Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida and Virginia National Ballet. In addition, he has performed as a guest dancer at various prestigious venues in Japan. Mr. Kaneko has won various prizes in Japanese national competitions such as the

50th Saitama Ballet Competition 2017 and the Nagoya National Ballet Competition 2016 and 2017 where he won first place. Mr. Kaneko joined MBT in 2020.



Kyrylo Kruhlov (Friend, Jazz Club Patron, Marine) Mr. Kruhlov is originally from Kyiv, Ukraine. He received his training at the Kyiv State Ballet School and graduated in 2014. Mr Kruhlov danced multiple roles with the National Opera of Ukraine, Novosibirsk State Academic Opera & Ballet Theatre, and with the Ukrainian Classical Ballet in Kyiv. Mr. Kruhlov joined MBT in 2022.

Hannah Locke (Friend, Jazz Club Patron) Ms. Locke, from Chattanooga, TN, began her training at VanCura Ballet Conservatory and attended high school on scholarship at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts under the direction of Ethan Stiefel. She attended summer intensives at Ballet Tennessee, Joffrey Midwest, American Ballet Theatre, Kaatsbaan and Boston Ballet. Ms. Locke began her professional career as a trainee with Richmond Ballet,



Ms. let, tet Tennessee. She has cluding Snow Queen

and later served as Principal Dancer and Ballet Administrator at Ballet Tennessee. She has performed a variety of featured roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Snow Queen in The Nutcracker, Myrtha in Giselle, Mina in Dracula, and the Mazurka in Les Sylphides. Ms. Locke joined MBT in 2018 and is also an instructor for Manassas Ballet Academy.
