



Prolugue: The Christening

King Florestan and his Queen celebrate the birth of their daughter, Aurora, by inviting everyone to a royal christening party. Among the invited guests are six fairies who bring special gifts to the baby: The gift of beauty, of grace, of never being hungry, of eloquence, of energy and finally, of wisdom. King Florestan had been told by Cattalabutte, his Master of Ceremonies, that everyone he knew had been invited. Suddenly, the fairy Carabosse arrives stating she had been forgotten, and she puts a curse on Aurora to die from a prick of her finger. The Lilac Fairy, however, says Aurora will not die, but will go to sleep for one hundred years to be awakened by a kiss from a Prince.

Intermission

Act I: The Spell

On her 16th birthday, Aurora is given a spectacular party to which everyone is invited, including four very handsome Cavaliers. She dances with the Cavaliers, receiving a rose from each of them. Towards the end of the party, a strange old woman appears and gives Aurora a bouquet of flowers in which a needle is hidden.

Intermission

Act II, Scene 1: The Vision

One hundred years later, Prince Florimund is hunting in the woods when, left alone, he dreams of an ideal love. The Lilac Fairy appears and shows him a vision of Aurora. Prince Florimund falls in love with Aurora and asks the Lilac Fairy to take him to her.

Act II, Scene 2: The Awakening

The Lilac Fairy leads Prince Florimund to the Palace, where ethe fights off Carabosse and her goblins and awakens Aurora with a kiss. The spell is broken.

Act III: The Wedding

The Prince and Princess' wedding day is a grand celebration.

BIOGRAPHIES



Amy Grant Wolfe (Artistic Director, Choreographer) Born in Buffalo, New York, Ms. Wolfe has a B.A. degree in Theater (Summa cum Laude) from Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio and a M.F.A. in Dance from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX where she twice received the Meadows Award as an outstanding dance student and won the Betty Ferguson Award as Outstanding Graduate student. As a professional dancer, Ms. Wolfe was a soloist with Ballet Dallas, Ballet Midland, Irving Ballet, Richardson Ballet, Dallas Metropolitan Ballet, Southwest Dance Collective, and Berea Summer Theatre. After Dallas Metropolitan dallet, Southwest Dallet Concerns, and 2 moving to Manassas in 1990, Ms. Wolfe became a teacher at the Manassas School of Dance

(now MBA) and a principal dancer with Manassas Dance Company (now MBT). In 1997, Ms. Wolfe became Associate Director of MBT and helped lead the expansion of the Company into a professional ballet company. In 1999, she became Artistic Director of Manassas Ballet Theatre. In 2008, Ms. Wolfe was presented with the Seefeldt Pioneer Award for Arts Excellence by the Prince William County Park Authority Arts Council for her contributions to the area's art community. Under her leadership, MBT has become the largest performing arts organization in Northern Virginia.

Christopher Hite (Music Director) Mr. Hite has served as conductor for performances with the Manassas Ballet Theatre since 1997. In 1999, he became the Music Director of the Company. Mr. Hite has conducted numerous ensembles in concert throughout the Washington area, including The National Gallery Orchestra, The Prince William Symphony Orchestra, Wind Works Chamber Ensemble, and The U.S. Air Force Band. A native of Columbus, Ohio, Mr. Hite holds degrees in Capital University and The Catholic University of America. In 1994, he was invited to participate in The Conductor's Institute at the University of South Carolina and has also conducted workshops held by The

Conductor's Guild of America, working with such notable artists as Yoel Levi, Paul Vermel, Lawrence Leighton Smith, Donald Portnoy, and others. Mr. Hite is the Music Director of the Dominion Symphony Orchestra, which held its inaugural performance in May 2008.



Vadim Slatvitskiy (Ballet Master, Choreographer, Cavalier, Young Gentleman of the Court) After graduating in 1989 from the Novosibirsk Ballet Academy in Russia, Mr. Slatvitskiy became the principal dancer with the Novosibirsk Theatre from 1989 until 2000 where he danced in many productions. In 2000, he became a principal dancer with the Grigorovich Ballet Company in Russia. He has also appeared as a guest dancer across the United States. He has danced the principal roles in The Nutcracker, Giselle, La Fille Mal Gardee, Don Quixote, Frankenstein and Cinderella just to name a few. Mr. Slatvitskiy has toured around the world, including countries such as Argentina, China, Egypt, England, Toured around the world, including countries seen as a sprimary choreographer, ballet master, and Germany and Italy. Mr. Slatvitskiy serves as primary choreographer, ballet master, and

dancer for Manassas Ballet Theatre as well as a principal teacher and Youth American Grand Prix coach for Manassas Ballet Academy. Mr. Slavitskiy joined MBT in 2006.

Renat Osmonov (Assistant Ballet Master, Gentleman of the Court, Cavalier, Puss' n Boots) Renat Osmonov is from Kyrgyzstan. He began his training at the Bishkek Choreographic School of ballet and continued his training in Perm State Choreographic College, specializing in Ballet Artistry. He received a bachelor's degree from the South Ural State Humanitarian Pedagogical University with additional education in Classical Dance Teacher. As a professional ballet dancer he has danced with the Saint Petersburg State Academic Ballet Theatre, the Moscow City Ballet under the direction of Smirnov-Golovanov, the Kyrgyz National Opera and Ballet Theatre, the Renaissance Russian Ballet and the Russian National Ballet under the direction of S. Radchenko. This is Renat's second time with MBT

Moscow, St. Petersburg and Kazakhstan. He is a member of the Manassas Ballet Academy faculty.

Wolfe Photograph and 2024 marks his fourth season with us. Mr. Osmonov is a teacher of classical dance having worked in

Gabriela Antuñano (White Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps, White Cat) Originally from Monterrey, Mexico, Ms. Antuñano started dancing at age 3. She danced jazz, tap, hip-hop, ballet, salsa, lyrical and contemporary. In 2018 she completed her ballet training at the Escuela Ballet de Monterrey. Gabriela is a 2020 Magna Cum Laude graduate from South Texas College with a Bachelor of Applied Sciences degree in Organizational Leadership. She won 1st place in the Starpower, Organizacion Juvenil de Danza and Interprepas Tec de Monterrey competitions and was a finalist at the World Ballet Competition. Gabriela previously danced with Ballet de Monterrey. She joined MBT in 2023.



Victoria Bartlett (Carabosse) Ms. Bartlett is a Maryland native and a 2016 graduate of Goucher College in Baltimore, where she finished Magna Cum Laude with a BA in dance and minor in psychology. Ms. Bartlett received a majority of her training at Glen Burnie, Maryland's, Edna Lee Dance Studio, where she eventually taught ballet, pointe, jazz and contemporary/lyrical as well as choreographed for the school. She was invited as guest artist by Howard County Ballet in 2013-2015 to dance Sugar Plum Fairy. Ms. Bartlett spent the 2016-17 season with Charlottesville Ballet as trainee and danced several corps de ballet roles, including The Nutcracker's Waltz of the Flowers. She has danced many roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Lucy and a Vampire

Wife in Dracula, Arabian and Lead Flower in the Nutcracker, and a Stepsister in Cinderella. Ms. Bartlett joined

MBT in 2017 and the Manassas Ballet Academy faculty in 2019.

Annemieke Bruce (Yellow Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps, Princess Florine) Born in Los Angeles, Annemieke began her training with Maria Whaley in Ashland, Kentucky. She continued her training, graduating from The Kirov Academy of Ballet in Washington DC. As a professional, Annemieke worked with the Classical Ballet in Charleston, SC, Ballet 5:8 in Chicago and Virginia National Ballet. From 2018 to 2022 Annemieke danced with the State Opera Stara Zagora in Bulgaria. Ms. Bruce joined MBT in 2022.

Adeline Campbell Prest (Red Fairy, Princess Florine, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps) Adeline began dancing at local studios in her hometown of Ottawa, Canada. She left home at है age fifteen for ballet training, first with Alberta Ballet, and then at Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet. She has supplemented her year round training with intensive programmes at The John Cranko Schule, Pennsylvania Ballet, The Royal Winnipeg Ballet, Ballet West, Oklahoma City Ballet, Orlando Ballet, Miami City Ballet, Ellison Ballet, Katsbaan Extreme Ballet, Complexions Contemporary Ballet, and others. She was a trainee at American Repertory Ballet, under the direction of Ethan Steiffel, before beginning her professional career as a Company Artist at De

La Dance Company of Cincinnati. Adeline joined the Company in 2023 and is an instructor at Manassas Ballet Academy.

Ting-Hsin Chang (Corps de Ballet Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps) Ting-Hsin Chang is from Chiayi, Taiwan, and began her dance training in Traditional Chinese dance, Modern and Ballet at the age of 9. She placed second at the 2020 Taiwan Grand Prix. In 2021, Ting-Hsin began her training at Ellison Ballet Professional Training Program in New York then continued her training with The Washington School of Ballet in 2023. At the World Ballet Art Competition Grand Prix semi-final in Taiwan, Ting-Hsin placed first in the junior division of 2020 and the senior division of 2023. Ting-Hsin attended the Final of the World Ballet Art Competition Grand Prix in Canada 2023, and she placed third. In 2024, Ting-Hsin placed first

in the classical category at the Hong Kong Youth Artist Competition. Ting-Hsin has also attended summer intensives with Universal Ballet, Bolshoi Ballet Academy, and Philadelphia Ballet. 2024 is her first season with Manassas Ballet Theatre.



Ruie-Lin Cheng (Gentleman of the Court, Cavalier, Prince Florine) Ruei Lin Cheng is from Taoyuan, Taiwan where he began his ballet training at the age of 6. He graduated from the Dance Department of the Affiliated Senior High School of National Taipei University of the Arts in 2023. During the 2023-2024 academic year, he studied at the Washington School of Ballet, where he performed in the Washington Ballet's production of "The Nutcracker" and participated in the school's production of Don Quixote. In 2022, Ruei Lin won 2nd place in the Junior B division of the 13th Taipei International Ballet Grand Prix. At the 2024 Youth America Grand Prix Semi-Final in Pittsburgh, he achieved 2nd place in the Senior Age Division Classical Category and 3rd place in the Senior Age Division Contemporary Category. He also

qualified for the 25th Youth America Grand Prix New York finals. Ruei Lin joined MBT in 2024.

Abby Fleming (Corps de Ballet Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps, Litle Red Riding Hood) Abby Fleming began her training at the age of 12 in Hattiesburg, Mississippi at the South Mississippi Ballet Theatre. Abby competing at YAGP finals in New York City, Abby trained at the Sarasota Ballet School, and at 18 became a trainee with Oklahoma City Ballet. The following year, she was promoted to Studio Company and remained there for 2 years. She then studied at Sarasota Cuban Ballet School and was accepted as a company dancer with Gulf Coast Company of the Sarasota Cuban Ballet School. She has also studied at American Ballet Theatre, Nutmeg Conservatory and the Bolshoi Academy New York. Abby has performed with the Ballet Nacional de Costa Ricain in Costa Rica and with Central New York Ballet in Syracuse, New York before joining MBT in 2024.





Nikoleta Giannakou (Corps de Ballet Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps) Nikoleta Giannakou was born and raised in Thessaloniki, Greece where she started her training, participating and winning first place on numerous regional and international competitions with her teacher mentor Inna Paramonova. In 2020 Nikoleta moved the the United States to pursue her dreams in dance. In 2024 she earned her BFA in dance and her BA in psychology from the University of St. Thomas in Houston. At the same time she trained at a professional level with Houston Ballet Dancers at Bayou City Ballet. She participated in numerous professional projects such as the 2023-2024 UK tour with the

International Classical Ballet Theatre of Marina Medvetskaya, Nikoleta joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in

2024.

Abigail Gorrell (Pink Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps) Ms. Gorrell is from Manassas, Virginia. She began dancing at the age of five and is a graduate of Manassas Ballet Academy. She was a regular participant in Youth America Grand Prix, and attended summer intensives with The School of Pennsylvania Ballet. As a student, Ms. Gorrell has performed various roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Clara in The Nutcracker. Ms. Gorrell joined the Company in 2022. Abigail is also an instructor at Manassas Ballet Academy.





Bryan Holtzer (Goblin, Young Gentlemen of the Court) was born in Manassas, Virginia. At the age of 3 he started classes in a variety of dance styles at the Warrenton Ballet Academy. He joined the Manassas Ballet Academy in 2019 and was a YAGP Semi-finalist in 2023. In 2024 Bryan was promoted to be a Student Apprentice of the Company. He has danced roles with MBT including the roles of Colin and Fritz.

Masaya Kaneko (Goblin, Young Gentleman of the Court, Blue Bird) Mr. Kaneko was born in Tokyo, Japan. He began his ballet training at Kamiya Ballet Art. Later he continued his studies at K-Ballet School and The Rock School for Dance Education. Mr. Kaneko has danced professionally with Alberta Ballet II, Arts Ballet Theatre of Florida and Virginia National Ballet. In addition, he has performed as a guest dancer at various prestigious venues in Japan. Mr. Kaneko has won various prizes in Japanese national competitions such as the 50th Saitama Ballet Competition 2017 and the Nagoya National Ballet Competition 2016 and 2017 where he won first place. Mr. Kaneko joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2020.





Sara Kuzminski (Corps de Ballet Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps) Holding American and Polish citizenship, she began her formal ballet training at age 14 at the New Jersey School of Ballet being mentored by Gabrielle Noa Abbate and later Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet under the direction of Marcia Dale Weary. Sara has attended numerous summer programs including Houston Ballet, Ballet Masterclasses Prague, Ballet West, Ballet Workshop Estonia, and Ballet Summer School Gdynia. She went on to join Ballet Chicago's studio company, Ruth Page C vic Ballet and later Triad International Ballet. Before joining MBT, she freelanced throughout Chicagoland, Georgia and Florida. Sara's joined MBT in 2024.



Hannah Locke (Fairy Corps, Peach Fairy, Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps, Princess Florine) Ms. Locke, from Chattanooga, TN, began her training at VanCura Ballet Conservatory and attended high school on scholarship at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts under the direction of Ethan Stiefel. She attended summer intensives at Ballet Tennessee, Joffrey Midwest, American Ballet Theatre, Kaatsbaan and Boston Ballet. Ms. Locke began her professional career as a trainee with Richmond Ballet and later served as Principal Dancer and Ballet Administrator at Ballet Tennessee. She has performed a variety of featured roles with Manassas Ballet Theatre including Juliet in Romeo and Juliet, Sugar Plum and Snow Queen in The Nutcracker, Myrtha in Giselle, Mina in Dracula, and Mazurka in Les Sylphides. Ms. Locke

joined MBT in 2018 and is also an instructor at Manassas Ballet Academy.

Devon Malin (Corps de Ballet Fairy Young Lady of the Court, Fairy Corps) From

Ringwood, New Jersey, Devon trained for seven years at the School of American Ballet. She also trained with Miami City Ballet, Alvin Ailey and Pacific Northwest Ballet. Before joining MBT she danced professionally with the Art of Motion Dance Theatre. Ms. Malin joined MBT in 2024.



Kurumi Miwa (Princess Aurora, Corps de Ballet Fairy) Ms. Miwa, from Tokyo, began her ballet training at age three. At 19 years old, she was awarded a merit scholarship to continue her training at the Joffrey Ballet School in New York under the direction of Era Jouravlev. At Joffrey, Ms. Miwa danced the role of Juliet in Romeo and Juliet and was a principal dancer in Naina's Magic Garden. Ms. Miwa also trained with the Central School of Ballet in London, the Royal Danish Ballet, Milwaukee Ballet, Oklahoma City Ballet, Maryland Youth Ballet, and she trained at Atlanta Ballet with full Scholarship. In 2018, Ms. Miwa won 1st place as well as the Technical Award and a Special Judges award at the Japan Ballet Competition. In 2019, she won 1st place

in the Jewels Ballet Festival Competition and 2nd place at the World Ballet Grand Prix in New York. She placed top 3 World Ballet Competition in Florida in 2021. Ms. Miwa joined Manassas Ballet Theatre in 2021.

Abigail Mottern (Corps de Ballet, Young Lady of the Court) Ms. Mottern is from Lake Ridge, VA. She began dancing at the age of 5 and joined Manassas Ballet Academy in 2017. She has additionally trained at attended the Richmond Ballet summer intensive and Joffrey Ballet Summer Intensive workshops. Abigail competed in both YAGP and D. C. Grand Prix. in 2024 she joined Manassas Ballet Theater in a student apprenticeship role. She performed many roles with MBT including Clara in the Nutcracker and Waltz of the Flowers in the Nutcracker.
